2015-2016 Annual Report of Rainbows United, Inc. President's Letter



I am pleased to report that Rainbows United, Inc. continues to remain strong even though we are compelled to function within a chaotic funding environment in Kansas. The Board of Directors and staff make children and families our highest priority in all that we do. Rainbows' staff served 100 more children than the prior year and is privileged to see on a regular basis small and big successes of children and youth as they learn to thrive. We love to hear the many stories of how Rainbows' services have positively impacted the lives of children and their families.

For the first time in our 44 year history, Rainbows raised a record \$1,011,000 in fundraising for operations and services! Breaking through the one million dollar ceiling has been our focus for the last two years. Rainbows has been successful raising millions of dollars for special projects such as capital campaigns and decreasing our debt during our restructuring period. We have not, however, been able to reach that \$1 million annual goal for services and general operations.

Rainbows is not able to carry out its Mission without accessing a number of different funding resources. We focus our fundraising efforts on special events, individual and corporate sponsorships, in-kind gifts, grants, foundations, major gifts, annual giving campaign, and Rainbows own Charitable Foundation.

In an effort to streamline Human Resources and Payroll, new Kronos software was implemented. As with most conversions similar to this, the process did not go as smoothly as hoped, but by being resourceful in finding solutions through intelligent decision making and great determination, we are happy to say that the new systems provide many internal efficiencies and allow staff to access their own personal information online. We are still learning all the capabilities of this new software.

Rainbows also updated its website RainbowsUnited.org to a mobile-responsive site. The redesign makes it easier for families to locate information. The revamped website turned out beautifully and is more user-friendly for all, no matter what electronic device one uses.

Through the responsible stewardship of our Board and staff, Rainbows was able to refinance our mortgage with a much lower interest rate, as well as to pay the loan down by \$700,000. This is a huge accomplishment that strengthens the organization.

As we look ahead, Rainbows continues to need your support. We cannot be successful without the help of many. It takes an entire team of staff and community volunteers to be able to maximize resources. I hope you will continue to be involved so families of children with special needs birth to age 21 can depend on needed services for their children. On behalf of the children and families served, thank you for your support.

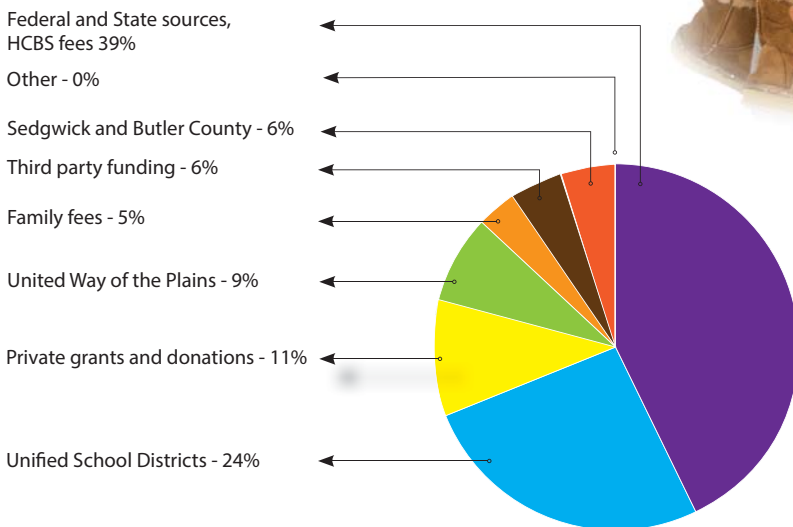

Spending Policy

The spending policy for the "Not Restricted or Temporarily Restricted Endowment Fund" shall be a maximum of six percent (6%) of the last 16-quarter rolling average, the last quarter being December 31 of the year prior to the year of distribution. The spending policy for Restricted Funds shall be in accordance with the donors' expressed restriction.

Rainbows United Charitable Foundation, Inc. is the preferred entity for all planned gifts, including endowment and estate gifts. Any unrestricted gift in which a donor has used the legal name of RUCF will be considered a gift designated solely for endowment.

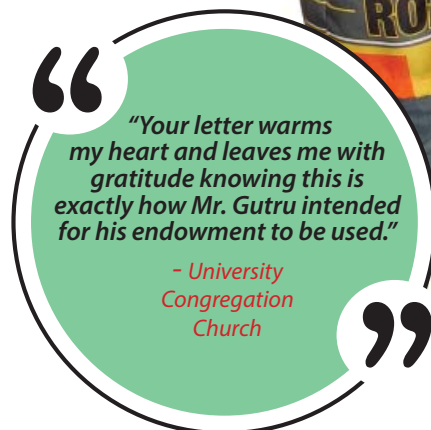
